2. The Thrust areas were formulated initially, was reframed, finalized and forwarded for approval to the University level committee.
3. Dr. Guru Prasad M S, presented the NISP Components using which the term plans have to be framed.
4. The Short, Mid and Long term plans are as follows:

A. Short term Plan (18 Months):

- To create awareness on Innovation, IP ownership, Creative & Design thinking, Entrepreneurship, Start Up culture among communities in the University.
- To organize webinars, seminars, workshops and faculty development programmes (FDPs), for students, faculty and alumni, and promote innovation and entrepreneurship culture in the University.
- To conduct events like ideathon to identify ideas that can be converted to products
- To perform regular evaluation of ideas by expert committee
- To set up an Entrepreneurship Development Cell Programme (EDP) Cell

B. Mid term Plan (36 Months):

- To provide pre-incubation facilities to faculty/student/alumni driven start-ups.
- To identify mentors to guide the community members
- To publish (IP/Patent/Papers) ideas and designs developed under the EDP Cell.
- To widen the research network, collaboration, tie-ups, attract financial aid, among other organizations, R&D Centers and individuals.

C. Long term Plan (60 Months):

- To establish an out-and-out incubation / innovation center within the university.
- To establish Centers of Excellence on the key thrust areas for intervention.
- To provide incentives, resources and awards to startups, facilitators, mentors and investors for the promotion of startups
- To establish a strategic association with Govt.of India-start up initiatives for mentoring, financial assistance and collaboration; in building the Innovation & Entrepreneurship activities.


